The intention of this \$250 award is to encourage and support those students whose love of music continues to be a part of their life. Preference will be given to submissions indicating a secondary education in music.

Application Criteria:

The applicant must:

- Be a student of the high school, graduating grade 12, from the *host town* (see bottom of page) of the Rockwood Festival of the Arts.
- Be currently enrolled in music courses (band, choral, RCM, etc.).
- Have participated in the Rockwood Festival of the Arts.

Please submit a letter expressing your musical interests, accomplishments, and goals. Describe when and how music became part of your life, what you've gained through these experiences, and how you plan to continue/share in the joy of music. Include all instruments and education you've experienced, and possible future pursuits. List your participation of music camps, community/school groups and especially the Rockwood Festival of the Arts, citing the number of years involved, in which discipline(s), and how you feel your attendance encouraged you to continue in your music education. Please include at least one letter from a personal reference(s) from your music teacher(s). References may be from school, private lessons, or community group director/instructor.

Deadline for submission is May 31st,
and should be dropped off with your high school music teacher (s).
